## FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

<b>Multi-child Discount:</b>	Deduct \$396 for second student, \$792 for third student, and \$1,188 for each additional student. Applies to grades 1 – 12 only.
<b>Church Discount:</b>	\$408 per student will be deducted for families who attend churches that have enrolled in the sponsoring church program.
<b>Referral Credit:</b>	Referring family earns a tuition credit for each first-time family who enrolls at least one student in grades K-12 and completes at least one quarter. Awarded as a tuition credit November 1. \$500 for traditional; \$250 for UMS
<b>EITC Referral Credit:</b>	Referring family earns 50% of EITC donation, up to \$250
<b>Payment Options:</b>	Pay in full by August 1 Two payments by August 1 and January 1 Ten or twelve month payments. Preauthorized debit to a checking or savings account is preferred. Option to pay by check is available. Ten payments – August through May. First payment is drafted on August 5. Twelve payments – July through June. First payment is drafted on July 5.
<b>NSF:</b>	Up to \$25 per check or direct debit not honored by the bank.
<b>Late Fee:</b>	\$25 per month may be assessed for any family whose tuition payments are not current at the end of the month.
<b>Early Withdrawal:</b>	Fee for early withdrawal is \$100 for each incomplete quarter, maximum \$400.
<b>Delinquent Accounts:</b>	Students whose tuition is more than thirty days in arrears at the semester break may be asked to withdraw.

## SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

### Application Process:

All scholarship eligibility is determined by PSAS (Private School Aid Service). The application can be requested from the office or can be downloaded and printed from our website, [www.lccs.cc](http://www.lccs.cc). The completed application, along with required documentation and payment, should be mailed directly to PSAS by April 18, 2012:

### Eligibility Guidelines:

Number of Dependents*	Maximum Income	Examples
1	\$72,000	Mom, Dad, one child \$72,000
2	\$84,000	Single Parent, one child \$72,000
3	\$96,000	Mom, Dad, two children \$84,000
4	\$108,000	Single parent, three children \$96,000
5	\$120,000 (add \$12,000 for each additional dependent)	

\*dependents listed on tax return, in addition to the child's parent(s)

These guidelines are firm for EITC funds; special circumstances will be considered for LCCS-provided scholarships.

The enrollment process must be completed before the scholarship award can be determined, but the scholarship application should be mailed to PSAS as early as possible. This is important because additional information is sometimes requested, causing this processing to be delayed.
