Senior Midterm Privilege

Midterms for all high school students are scheduled from 8:10 am until 12:00 noon on Wednesday and Thursday, January 12 and 13. There are two exams given each day in math, science, social studies, and English classes. Students who have midterms in other classes will be taking them during regularly-scheduled class times during the weeks of January 3 and 10.

As a senior privilege, seniors who do not have a midterm scheduled during all four of the test periods may arrive late to school in time to take their exam or may leave after their first exam is completed. They must have a note signed by their parent giving them permission to do so. Students need to sign in or out with the Leola Campus receptionist. They must leave the campus immediately or else report to their assigned study period.

Seniors must arrive by 8:10 am or between 10:00 and 10:20 am if they do not have a midterm exam during the first time slot.

Seniors who do not have an exam during the second time slot must leave the building no later than 10:20 am or else report to their assigned study hall.

All high school students are finished at noon. They must leave the campus immediately following their exams.

Midterms and Snow

In case of a snow delay during midterm exams the high school students will not be dismissed at noon. The schedule will be as follows:

- Attendance in first period class: 10:10 – 10:30
- First session midterm: 10:30 – 12:15
- Lunch and break: 12:15 – 1:00
- Second session midterm: 1:00 – 2:45

Any seniors who do not have a midterm during one of the sessions should follow this schedule to ensure that they are on campus and do not miss a test.
