- \* 16 different china plates (older floral patterns preferred, but not necessary) – no plastic! They need to be plaster or ceramic. They do not have to match, so if you have a set of eight or four, that’s fine. Another family may donate some, as well.
- \* 2 old table cloths (Lace/white preferred)
- \* 8 different salt shakers (Ceramic) - non matching better
- \* 8 different pepper shakers (Ceramic) - non matching better
- \* PRINTING PRESS circa 1920's-30's
- \* type stick (for press)
- \* letters for type (for press)
- \* type box (for press)
- \* hat/coat tree/rack (dark wood preferred, but light wood is fine, as well)
- \* small wooden stool (foot stool)
- \* glass or metal butter dish
- \* large feathered darts (size of yard darts) and dart board
