Lunch Program

Lunch tickets can be purchased at anytime from the receptionist at both campuses. They will be sold in packs of 20 @ 3.25 for a total cost of \$65.00. The meal ticket will include everything that is listed on the menu for the day. The menu can be seen on RenWeb. Lunch tickets can be purchased and used at either campus.

West Lampeter Campus Lunch: Please note this change for ordering. Any students that come to school after 8:30 am must place their lunch order with the receptionist when signing in at the Welcome Center. Elementary students can buy tickets from their teacher each day and middle school students can purchase lunch with cash if they aren't able to purchase the pack of lunch tickets. If you did not receive the lunch news at Back-to-School night please have your student ask for one at the Welcome Center. This has information about the lunch program at the West Lampeter Campus.

Leola Campus Lunch: Students at the Leola Campus may use lunch tickets or cash to purchase lunch. Lunch items can also be purchased a la carte. Menu pricing for a la carte items can be found on the calendar on ParentsWeb. Along with the main meal the following items will be available for purchase everyday: white and chocolate milk, Capri sun, water, cheese sticks, yogurt, fresh fruit and granola bars.
