How to Access LCCS ParentsWeb

ParentsWeb is a private and secure website that has been set up for our school to allow parents to see complete information specific to their child. Parents can view student's grades, attendance, homework and conduct, as well as other useful school information. Parents can also communicate with teachers and other school staff online whenever necessary. All parents need is an Internet-capable computer. Picture Day
